Message from the Superintendent

This year, a committee of alumni from the New Waterford Schools, the Fairfield Schools and the Crestview Schools have organized to consolidate our alumni into one unified alumni organization. In addition to providing support for the Crestview Schools and our students, The Crestview Local Alumni Association will provide a procedure to recognize the achievements of alumni and friends of our schools. One of the fundamental purposes of the Crestview Local Alumni Association will be to organize and create the Crestview Distinguished Hall of Fame. The Crestview Distinguished Hall of Fame will recognize and perpetuate the names of those men and women who have distinguished themselves through meritorious service, contributing to the prestige and progress of the Crestview Local School District and/or our community. The nominee need not be a graduate of Crestview High School.



The qualifications for induction into Crestview Distinguished Hall of Fame will include:

- Nominees must have been out of school at least 15 years prior to the year of nomination.
- Nominations must be made on an official nominating form. Nomination forms are included in this month's *Informagram* and will be available in the administration offices of Crestview Schools. Nominations will be kept permanently and will be reevaluated annually. Deadline for nominations is March 1, 2008 for this year's class of inductees.
- Nominees must have made a significant and recognizable contribution to society or their profession; or candidates must have been recognized for performance in the arts, athletics, government or public service; or they must have advanced the cause of education, science or medicine through practice or research; or they have been recognized for other outstanding achievement.
- Candidates may be nominated and inducted posthumously.
- Any supporting materials such as newspaper magazine or professional articles may be submitted with the nomination form.
- If possible, the nomination should include a picture of the candidate.
