Message from the Superintendent

Dear Rebel Family:



This year, Crestview Local Schools will physically make up school days with students after eight (8) closures or calamity days during the 2021 - 2022 school year. We are currently at five (5) days of closures. In years past, when there were harsh winters, the state has waived the make up days. This is sometimes confusing, but for this year we wanted our community to know where we currently stand. For the next three calamity days (days 6,7,& 8), students will be assigned “blizzard bags” or electronic assignments to do at home if we have a closure.

After eight (8) days of closure, any additional days closed, will have to be made up in person. If this happens, our first scheduled make-up day would be, Monday, April 18, 2022. This is the day after Easter in accordance with our school calendar. Our hope is that we will not even need to address make-up days or any additional calamity days. We do encourage you to have your child read on any days off. Our teachers are busy preparing lessons, reading educational articles, grading, preparing their classroom and perfecting their craft during these closure days. Learning is an opportunity and we still need to grow our students. It is just sometimes, the weather makes it unsafe for our buses, students, and staff to travel.

[The calendar](#) for the 22-23 school year has been approved and is now available for your planning purposes; however, we have a lot of days of learning left in the current school year. Our principals and buildings have published dates for spring testing. On March 8, 2022, we will be administering the ACT to all high school juniors for free. Due to the requirements by the ACT board, all HS staff will be needed to administer testing on this day. Therefore, Grades 9, 10, and 12 will be learning remotely on that day. All other grade levels will attend school as normal. HS students in grades 9, 10 and 12 that are not taking the ACT, will have assignments in their Google Classroom. All students will be in school, whether tested or untested on every day but one.

Our 2nd conference night will be Thursday, February 17th. Conferences will be held in person; however, if you need a virtual or phone conference we will accommodate if possible. There are no classes from Friday, February 18 to Monday, February 21, 2022, in honor of the President’s weekend.

We extend congratulations to our HS Academic Challenge team that finished second in the county. Our HS robotics team competed in the County Competition on Saturday, January 29th and qualified for state. Our athletic winter sports will all begin tournament play in February. All of those games are managed by the State of Ohio and tickets will be on sale electronically through our website. Please come out and support our kids, especially on senior night! In March we will have several events, so mark your calendar! On Thursday, March 24, at 6 p.m. we will hold Rebel Pride night! We did this several years ago, and had a great turnout. We will highlight several programs, our school and have various activities and prizes. Also, our drama department will be performing *Anastasia* on March 18, 19, and 20. We hope that you come out and support our local talent.
