## *Message from the Superintendent*



Dear Rebel Nation and Class of 2020:

We are blessed and excited to partner with YSN Network in assisting us in planning a memorable graduation program for our students and families. Although we cannot physically be together, we will still celebrate the accomplishments of the mighty Class of 2020! We were the first school to sign an agreement with YSN to handle our sporting events. Now, we are the first for graduation. YSN will stand for "Your Senior Network".

Over the last several weeks we have attempted to schedule alternate dates for spring events. However, with Governor DeWine's announcement from April 20, 2020 that schools will remain closed for this year, our plan is still adjusting. In addition, he stated that schools may be in a blended learning format in the fall, and social gathering restrictions will remain in effect for the summer. It is then, most unlikely, that our seniors would have no closure and recognition as a whole. In addition, several members of the Class of 2020 will be going to the military and with AmeriCorps within weeks after graduation. Therefore, to celebrate the gifts of the Class of 2020 as a whole, we will host graduation together on May 17, 2020 as scheduled. The event will be streamed via YSN at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 17, 2020. The week leading up to the event will include families and graduates being filmed, and it will all be put together for Sunday.

We ask the community to join us in honoring our seniors on Friday, May 8, 2020. At 7:00 p.m. a parade will drive off from the school. The parade will travel down Crestview Road into New Waterford and then turn left and end at Route 46. The parade will not only honor our seniors, but it will honor our spring athletes, first responders, and other essential workers. The parade is spread out over 3 miles so that families can view safely from their cars along the parade route. The only people who will be on school property will be our parade participants, who will stay in their cars as we drive through the community.

We would really like to thank our families for working with the best staff on the planet during this unusual time. All of us have had to change and adjust to unique circumstances. As adults, we have had to learn new things ourselves, which is an essential trait to teach our students: Learning is a lifelong process. I am blessed to see so many talented, caring people that go far beyond the call of duty. Our staff has fed the mouths, minds, and souls. I cannot thank everyone enough for their hard work and persistence. I could not be more proud of our staff and community. Go Rebels!

Life is precious, and I know the last six weeks have taught me to appreciate the little things much more! I greatly miss our kids and the talent they display. I cannot wait until we can get together again and watch plays, concerts, and games. Who knows? Maybe the scientist who can stop us from the next pandemic is right here in Crestview School District.
