The month of September looks to be a full calendar of academics, athletics and student activities to begin the school year. I am pleased to inform you that our staff immersed themselves from the beginning to instruct our students and deliver quality instruction on day one. In addition to the daily academic rigor, our students are involved in many athletic and after school events. Fall parent-teacher conferences are scheduled for October 6, 2022. On this day we will have early dismissal for students. 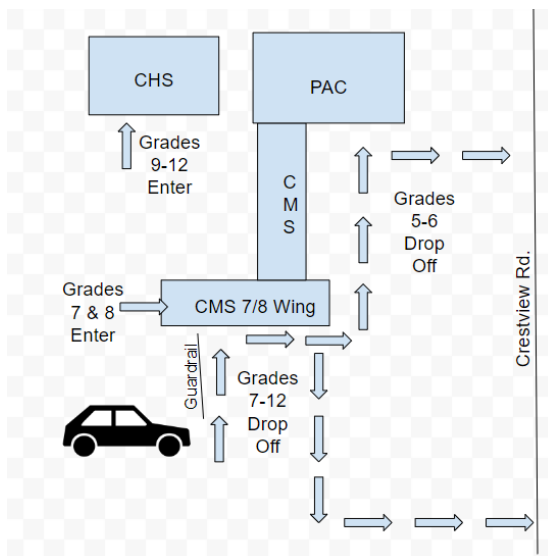
## TRANSPORTED STUDENTS

### **PARKING PERMITS**

Students must submit a copy of their driver's license and proof of current valid car insurance along with \$20.00 (checks made payable to Crestview Schools or cash). All student drivers must have a parking permit and participate in random student drug screening, if they have not already done so as a student athlete. ### **IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS**

Students entering 12th grade in the fall of 2022 are required to have 2 doses of meningococcal (serogroup A, C, W and Y) vaccine. If your child received the first dose of the vaccine after the 16th birthday, a second (2nd) dose is not required.
